Module Aims

The module aims to enable students, working independently, to demonstrate the ability to plan and carry out a critical study of an identified problem area that integrates concepts, theories, knowledge and skills encountered on the programme.

**Outline Syllabus** 

This is an independent piece of work with students working under the supervision of an allocated academic tutor. Students will be allocated an academic supervisor with whom they will meet regularly.

Workshops will include guidance on: identifying an area of specialist focus; producing a proposal; literature searching.

## Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy

Learning is mainly through independent study, supported by workshops, VLE materials and academic supervision. Students will produce a proposal for their study (LO 1, 4, 5) to test its soundness and to identify appropriate academic supervision. Under supervision the student will produce a study of an area of specialist focus (LO 1, 2, 3, 4, 5).

The module is assessed by a 10 minute presentation of the research proposal and a 3000 word study of an area of specialist focus.
