The Nursing and Midwifery Council (2023) Standards for pre-registration nursing programmes require students to complete 2,300 hours of practice learning by the end of the programme, these have been distributed across the programme to support your learning and achievement of the Future nurse: Standards of proficiency for registered nurses (2024). Stage one of the programme has been mapped to Part one of the MYEPAD and practice learning opportunities have been scaffolded throughout the stage to support your skills development, knowledge and understanding.

To proceed into the next stage/ part of the programme you must achieve a minimum of 85 percent (612 hours) of the allocated practice hours and have these verified and signed in the MYEPAD by a Practice supervisor/Practice assessor. If you do not complete and have evidence of 85 percent of the verified practice hours at the end of the stage, the module will be recorded as a fail, and you will not be eligible to progress to the next stage of the programme until the hours have been completed.

If you achieve between 612 and 719 hours, you will be eligible to progress, you must however achieve any deficit of hours during stage two.

Throughout the stage you will have support from your Academic Assessor to discuss and monitor your achievement of the practice hours requirement. You will also be supported throughout your programme journey by your Personal Academic Tutor who can offer support, advocacy and signposting.

Throughout this stage, support will be available as detailed in practice module one.
