Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy

To prepare students for the health numeracy examination, you will be introduced to the safeMedicate ePlatform which can be used as a digital tool to self-assess your numeracy progression. Students will be provided with multiple opportunities to complete the assessment throughout programme. Students will be expected to continue to undertake independent learning to meet their practice learning outcomes. Students will be introduced to the numeracy examination at multiple points during the practice modules.

Students will have up to five opportunities to achieve the health numeracy assessment over the length of the programme, commencing in year two.

Students will be supported to work with their Academic Assessor and Personal Academic Tutor to agree reasonable adjustments where required and can access their support throughout the year.

Students can access learning support for their numeracy, digital and technological literacy from the University Academic Skills Advice Service, the International Study Centre, the library and Disability Service. Details about these services can be found in the My Bradford hub on campus, or via your Personal Academic Tutor.
