Module Aims

This module aims to provide students with the opportunity to:

- Gain experience of clinical pharmacy in the UK, by attending placement within different healthcare sectors.
- Reflect on their experiences and identify key learning and action points.

Outline Syllabus

Placement topics will include: introduction to UK pharmacy practice in primary and secondary care in a variety of settings, professionalism, professional socialisation and professional identity, undertaking a learning needs analysis and developing a learning action plan and reflecting on experiences in practice.

Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy

Learning outcome 1 will be met by attendance on clinical placements, which the University will arrange. Students will be given introductory tutorials to orientate them to the different sectors of practice and expectations of placement providers. Students will also consider what they hope/need to learn from the placement and how it will help them to improve practice in their own organisation.

Students will undertake at least 140 hours of placement. The assessment will include attendance at placement (pass/fail) and a written reflection on the learning gained from placement.

There is a minimum attendance threshold for the placement (100 hours) which must be met in order to pass the module. Students MUST PASS the attendance requirement in order to pass the module.
